Choosing to rehome your dog is a big decision.

# How we work

#### STEP 1

Our first priority is always to help you keep your dog.

We can help find trainers or behavioursts local to you who can assist you in overcoming issues you might be having. Often owners have not been able to find the right help and we can recommend other avenues.

# STEP 2

If you have exhausted all options that allow you to keep your dog then the next step is to make contact with your breeder and let them know of the issues you are having. You may already have a contract in place with your breeder so check out the options they can offer.

# STEP 3

If there is no pathway for your dog back through the breeder then CRD Aid UK may be able to offer care and rehoming.

# **OPTION 1**

You can choose to keep your dog at home while the rehoming process is carried out. We will work on your behalf to find suitable candidates for rehome and they will visit you to meet the dog and you can decide if your dog should go to them. It is important that over this time you committ to neutering your dog at your own expense, and provide evidence of the procedure to us.

### **OPTION 2**

You can choose to relinqush your dog into our care. Transport will be arranged by us, at your cost, by a licensed pet transporter. Your dog will be taken direct to our licensed and registered boarding premises where they will have facilties similar to a home environment with their own spacious room separate to any and all other dogs to sleep in at night. Whilst with us your dog will be assessed, trained if applicable, and we will cover relevant vaccinations whilst in our care and also ensure neutering takes place. Rehoming will be via an adoption process which will incurr an adoption fee to the new owner which will be an equivalent amount to cover vaccinations, training and neutering.

At every stage of the journey your details and situation will be kept 100% confidential, as will those of potential and eventual adopters.
